



The Case...

- 36 weeks gestation, partial abruption
 Apgars 2, 7
- Fever developed day 3, tachycardia noted 240-270 bpm



- No slowing of the rate in response to facial ice or adenosine
- Transesophageal lead dropped and adenosine administered



Congenital Junctional Ectopic Tachycardia!

- External surface cooling
- Intravenous Digoxin, Procainamide
- No slowing...ventricular dysfunction, heart failure and anasarca develop
- Two episodes of ventricular fibrillation, successfully converted via DC current cardioversion
- Procainamide & Digoxin dc'd, Amiodarone started
- Persistent tachycardia 260 bpm, Esmolol infusion started
- Persistent hypotension, acidosis [bicarbonate infusion started]
- Now 9 days of failed therapy heart rate still >250 bpm....
















15 watts of energy at 20 secs, impedance of 130 ohms

Electrograms from His Bundle RF Catheter




